

New Pedestrian Signal Activated

The new traffic signal for pedestrian crossing at Floating Feather and Thunderbird Ave. is now functioning.

Beginning Monday, September 28th, Eagle Hills Elementary will have a crossing guard to cross children from 8:35—9:05 in the morning and 3:45—4:15 in the afternoon on school days.

The “Brown” Bus (#98-15) that now services the Brookwood Subdivision will service bus riders through September 30th.

Beginning on October 5th, all students that ride the “Brown” bus will walk to the crossing signal to cross Floating Feather Road and proceed to Eagle Hills Elementary or home.

Please practice this procedure with your students in the next week and possibly form a “walking school bus” with your neighbors.

A similar signal is also being activated at Floating Feather and Seven Oaks Way.
